The Chelmsford Art Society is pleased to feature Marilene Sawaf who will demonstrate working with casein. Born in Alexandria, Egypt, the artist lived in Europe, Africa and the Middle East. After coming to the USA in 1980, her first paintings were inspired by her education in Interior Design and Architecture while she leaned toward enigmatic, colorful images. Presently, she lives in Hollis, NH.

Sawaf has given Demonstrations and Talks about art all over New England. Some of her presentations included many in New Hampshire, the Whistler House Museum of Art in Lowell, MA and for the Chelmsford Art Society in 2005.

On her website, the artist lists numerous art shows where she has shown her work since 2006. In 2006 and 2008 she received awards from the Currier Museum of Art for her figurative paintings. In 2011, she became a member of the Copley Society of Boston.

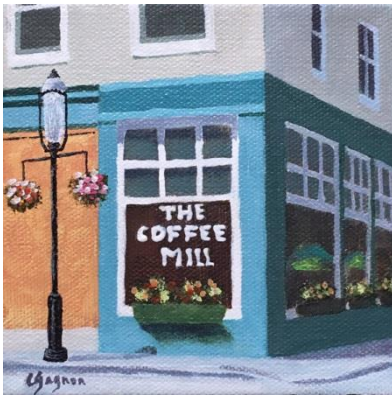

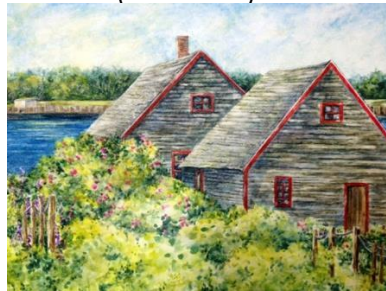

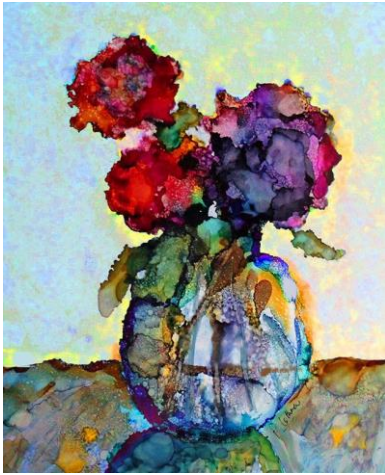
