February - April Demonstrations

February Demo - Leo Mancini-Hresko

Leo Mancini-Hresko demonstrated painting a portrait at the February meeting of the CAS. His model was long-time CAS member **Claire Gagnon**.

Leo was born in Boston and taught art for many years in Italy. He currently maintains a studio at Waltham Studios in Waltham, MA. Leo works with Boston realists like Tom Dunlay, and he paints en plein air in all seasons. In addition to portraits, he enjoys painting still lifes, figures, cityscapes and old ruins. His artwork is on exhibit internationally.

March Demo - William Cheever Turner

William Cheever Turner presented an interesting *Talk About* Art at the Chelmsford Art Society's March meeting. The artist paints in a realistic manner, and ascribes human attributes to things that are not human, such as in his series of timeworn trucks, cars and farm equipment.

He received his art education at several art schools including a BFA from the New Hampshire Institute of Art, Manchester, NH, classes on Color Theory at the MFA in Boston, and Master of Visual Arts-Painting, NH Institute of Art, Manchester, NH. He is a member of the Oil Painters of America, Copley Society of Art, Boston, MA and Whistler House Museum, Lowell, MA. William is a resident of Milford, NH.


