After hearing about a new school in Georgia, Decorating Masters Institute, she enrolled and here learned many of the methods to create trompe l'oeil (fool the eye) effects.

She is a member of the Arts League of Lowell and maintains a studio at Western Ave. Studios, 122 Western Ave. 5th Floor, Studio #29, Lowell, MA.
