# SPRING 2016 ONE DAY PLEIN AIR WORKSHOPS AT GRIGGS FARM

# ATTEND ONE, TWO OR ALL THREE DAYS : Friday May 20th, Saturday June 4th and Saturday June 11th

Location: Griggs Farm Billerica from 9:00 a.m-4:00 p.m.

Cost: \$60.00 Per Day

Lunch: 12-1 There is a sandwich shop, a salad bar and an ice cream stand next door.

This workshop is for all levels. Any demonstrations will be in oil but acrylic painters are welcome. There will be a short presentation each morning. The schedule will allow for a morning and an afternoon painting. We will paint in the greenhouses with filtered light in the event of inclement weather.

<u>Suggested Materials:</u> Please bring two linen or canvas panels 6x8-11x14. I have extra easels (be sure to let me know if you need one)!

<u>Paint:</u> Keep it simple (these are only suggestions). Titanium White, Ivory Black, Rembrandt Transparent Red and Viridian, Cad. Red, Alizarin, Yellow Ochre, Cad. Yellow, Cad Lemon, Ultramarine Blue, either Cerelean Blue <u>or</u> Severes, (specialty colors you may want for flowers Perm Rose etc...).

Brushes: Suitable assortment

<u>Turpentine</u> (Rectified if possible) <u>Mineral spirits or turp</u>. for clean up, <u>Paper Towels</u>, <u>Wet Ones</u>,

Sketch Pad, Pencil or Charcoal, View finder, Hat, Stool, Palette,
