February - April Demonstrations

Peter Koutrouba demonstrated his vibrant use of colorful pastels on Feb. 22nd while creating an image of a beautiful lily. He also entertained the audience with stories from his long military career.

Mary Rose O'Connell demonstrated a fascinating oil painting technique on March 29th when she randomly applied three oil colors to a canvas with a bristle brush and magically created a tonal painting using paper towels as brushes to remove the lighter areas! Mary Rose used turpentine to wipe out the lightest areas. The colors she used were viridian, ivory black and transparent red oxide. She described this technique as "very freeing", and admonished not to overwork the painting.

Andrew Kusmin talked about his artwork and discussed his new book, "Palette of Dreams" at the April 26th meeting. He is a well-known, prolific watercolor artist, art instructor and the owner of the Kusmin Art Gallery in Plymouth, MA.

Andrew's book is not a "How-To" book, but rather explores "what shall I paint" and "why am I painting it". His book is the story of one man's journey to answer the artist's question "why to paint". His paintings are stories of multiples, changing images, and memories of places, things and people. The book features more than 200 of Andrew's original paintings presented in nine chapters that reflect the various themes.

Signed copies of his book were available at the meeting.

<u>Other</u> – Field Trip Coordinator, Volunteers Coordinator, Webmaster



May 31st CAS Program: Maris Platais

Please note that the following program will be held at the Chelmsford Center for the Arts, 1A North Rd, Chelmsford, MA.

This will be the final program of the 2016 – 2017 season. A new slate of programs will begin in September.

Maris Platais will be presenting a demonstration of acrylic painting techniques on Wed. May 31.

A native of Latvia, the artist has lived in New England since 1949. As a boy, the artist always was drawing, and after high school he enrolled in a joint degree program at Tufts University and the Boston Museum School.

After serving in the United States Marine Corp, he worked as an advertising executive while concurrently teaching drawing at the Museum of Fine Arts.

Since 1982, he has devoted his full time to the fine arts. Platais lectures, demonstrates and has served as a juror for many organizations including the New England Watercolor Society. He has won many awards including four Awards for Excellence in the Mystic International, also for the Arts for the Parks competition in Jackson Hole, Wyoming. He has exhibited at the Boston Museum of Fine Arts, the Worcester Art Museum, and the Smithsonian Institution

To quote Maris, "When I paint or draw a landscape, I am seeing a much more complex thing than just trees, streams, clouds and boats, I am seeing a harmony of colors, of place, of feeling, of atmosphere, and that is something I like to share with people."

About the Chelmsford Art Society


All residents of Chelmsford, Massachusetts and its surrounding communities who have an interest in the arts and crafts are invited to become members of the Chelmsford Art Society.
