

March Demonstration

The Chelmsford Art Society is featuring Jay Wolcott Hungate who will present a sculpture demonstration at the monthly meeting. A professional sculptor, he makes original designs in plasticine clay and utilizes traditional mold making practices to make a plaster copy of the original. With rubber molds of the finished pieces, he can cast copies in plaster and cement. These he sells these to gift shops and individuals.

A graduate with honors from Massachusetts College of Art, Jay maintains two studios. One as a resident artist at the *Brush Gallery* and the other at 122 Western Avenue, an old mill building where he can be seen working in marble and other stone. He shows these pieces at fine art galleries and exhibitions. He has exhibited in many shows throughout New England. Most recently at *The Mill Brook Gallery & Sculpture*

Garden, Concord, NH and The Barn Gallery, Ogunquit, ME.

He has just stepped down as the President of the *New England Sculptors Association* and is a member of the *Arts League of Lowell* as well as other associations.

His demonstration for the Chelmsford Art Society will be on Tuesday, March 27, 2007, at 7 PM at the Old Town Hall.

National Endowment for the Arts Funding Opportunity

Starting in 2007 in the area of "Presenting" the NEA now has a separate focus and panel for Outdoor Festivals, Programs and Outdoor Dramas. The grant category in which this program falls is called "Access to Artistic Excellence."

It is designed to encourage and support artistic excellence, preserve our cultural heritage, and provide access to

the arts for all Americans.

An organization may request a grant amount from \$5,000 to \$150,000. For information and guidelines, enter this url onto your browser: www.arts.gov/grants/apply/GAP08/Pres entingAAE.html

Please note: The NEA (www.NEA.gov) is transitioning to requiring organizations to file electronically through Grants.gov, the federal government's online applica-tion system. It is optional this year, but mandatory in 2008. To apply electronically, organizations need to register with <u>Grants.gov</u> as soon as possible. This onetime registration process must be completed before you can submit your grant application. The process can take two weeks, so it is extremely important that you begin the registration process immediately. The deadline for applications is March 12.
