The judges for the 4th of July Art Show have been chosen. They are:

Maris Platais - A noted artist and teacher who devotes his time lecturing and demonstrating to art associations throughout the Northeast. He holds classes in Lexington and Concord.

James Sullivan - Well known in this area. Sullivan is an artist and an accomplished artwork framer. He is the former owner of the Art Room in Chelmsford and has contributed to the Art Society for many years.

Jack Ebel - A fine art photographer and artist. In the US Navy, he worked as a naval photographer. For 35 years he continued as a filmmaker, cinematographer and film director with CBS, PBS and industrial films. After his retirement, he also began painting.

A Glimpse of Europe « Plein Air » Day

The Andover Artist Guild is inviting the CAS to this great event.
