Levine treated us to a wonderful demonstration of her pastel technique, working from a photo from Cobbs Cook Bay in Edmunds, Maine. Her favorite pastel materials include LaCarte paper with a microfilament coating in a number of colors including gray and salmon, (but never white) and Terry Ludwig or Mt. Vision pastels. Levine said she's been on "cloud kick" in her artwork lately and this certainly showed in the beautiful and colorful piece she created. It was mostly sky and clouds and the reflection of sky and clouds.


